17th&18th April. Club Lotus Show & Festival: The 24th Annual Club Lotus Show and Festival takes place at Malvern Three Counties Showground on 17-18 April 2010. This is the biggest and best attended indoor Lotus Show in Europe and regularly attracts over 8,000 enthusiasts from all over the world.

There will be lots to see and do, including club displays, trade stands and autojumble. Two important anniversaries will also be celebrated at the show - the 50th anniversary of Lotus' first Grand Prix victory, when Stirling Moss triumphed at Monaco, and the 40th anniversary of Lotus and Jochen Rindt becoming world champion before tragedy struck at the Italian Grand Prix.



9 -11 July Le Mans Classic : A few of our members have booked ferry and camp sites for this great event.

Practice for the le Mans Classic 2010 begins on Friday afternoon when each grid is on track for a daytime and a nighttime session, going on until the early hours. The first race for each grid begins ears of corn style, which is a wonderful sight. Each grid will race three times during the 24 hours, on the full Le Mans circuit and a driver change during each stint is obligatory.
