Two important anniversaries will also be celebrated at the show - the 50th anniversary of Lotus' first Grand Prix victory, when Stirling Moss triumphed at Monaco, and the 40th anniversary of Lotus and Jochen Rindt becoming world champion before tragedy struck at the Italian Grand Prix.
